

CHURCH IN REGINA

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*Go therefore and disciple
all the nations, baptizing them
into the name of the Father and
of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.
~ Matt.28:19*

The name Jesus has three elements. The first is Jehovah. What a great thing that Jehovah is in the name Jesus. The second element is Savior. Jesus is not just Jehovah but the One who is our Savior. The name Jesus also implies that this Savior becomes our very salvation. **These three elements—Jehovah, Savior, and salvation—comprise the name of Jesus. We should never take these elements for granted.**

Jehovah

The name Jesus includes the name Jehovah, which means “I Am Who I Am,” indicating that Jehovah is the self-existing and ever-existing eternal One, the One who was in the past, who is in the present, and who will be in the future forever (Exo. 3:14 ; Rev. 1:4). Exodus 3:14 and Revelation 1:4 are very important. When God came to Moses in Exodus, He introduced Himself, saying, “I AM WHO I AM.” And He said, “Thus you shall say to the children of Israel, I AM has sent me to you” (3:14). This One is I Am. Consider the implication of His being the I Am. He is the eternal One. **He always is.** In the past, in the present, and forever, He was, is, and will always be the I Am. **He will always be in the present tense—the I Am.** This is not a small thing. **Our life is measured by time.** We are created beings, but He as the I Am is not. He is not dependent on anything or anyone. We are limited by both space and time, so we are only in the present. We thank the Lord that although He is not limited by time, He is also and is always in the now. He is the I Am. We may ask, “Lord, You say that You are I Am, but what are You?” Eventually, He is everything, and He is whatever we need of Him.

Savior

The name of Jesus is for us to be saved (Acts 4:12). We were saved when we believed into the name of Jesus. We were saved from God’s condemnation. We were saved from judgment. We were saved from hell and the lake of fire. However, there are many other things from which we still need to be saved. Romans 10:13 says, “Whoever calls upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.” When we called, we were saved from a host of things, but 5:10 says, “If we, being enemies, were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more we will be saved in His life, having been reconciled.” **Although we have been saved from God’s condemnation, there are still many things from which we need to be saved.** Sometimes we just need to be saved from our mood, even our temper. At times, we become disappointed and discouraged, have doubts, and are fearful. We need to be saved from all these things. Sometimes we need to be saved from unbelief. We come to a conference, hear a word, and are happy and even excited. Eventually, the enemy lies to us, saying, “Everyone can make it except you.” This did not come from your mind; it is the enemy’s attack. At that moment we can call “O Lord Jesus. Lord Jesus, do not just save me, but come and be my salvation.” **He will be our Savior at that moment just by our calling on His name.**

Salvation

Psalms 116:13 says, “I will take up the cup of salvation / And call upon the name of Jehovah.” He wants to be our salvation. He even wants us to drink of the springs of salvation by calling on His name (Isa. 12:3). Sometimes we are in a situation in which all we can muster to say is “O Lord.” Yet in that situation, **He comes to be whatever we need Him to be.**

We need to call with a pure lip. Zephaniah 3:9 says, “I will change the language of the peoples / Into a pure language / That they may all call upon the name of Jehovah, / To serve Him with one accord.” This verse has the phrase a pure language, but the Hebrew literally says “a pure lip.” We need to have a pure lip. If we call with an impure lip, we may not enjoy the deep sweetness and richness of the Lord. **Nothing contaminates our lips more than loose talk.** We need to repent of our loose talk and enjoy the cleansing of the blood. Isaiah was a man of unclean lips in the midst of a people of unclean lips, but his lips were touched and made clean (Isa. 6:5-7). We may be involved in gossip, loose talk, criticism, or even a curse. How can we then enjoy the richness and the Lord’s salvation when we call? We first have to confess to purify our lips (Excerpts from The Ministry of the Word (vol.30, no.01, pp.69-99).
